- * Please do not put your academy name or logo on the design.

- * Each academy will send OAT marketing all entries via email (marketing@ormistonacademies.co.uk) and OAT/OT will select the winner(s) and runners-up designs together.
- * Deadline for entry is **Wednesday 9 November**.
