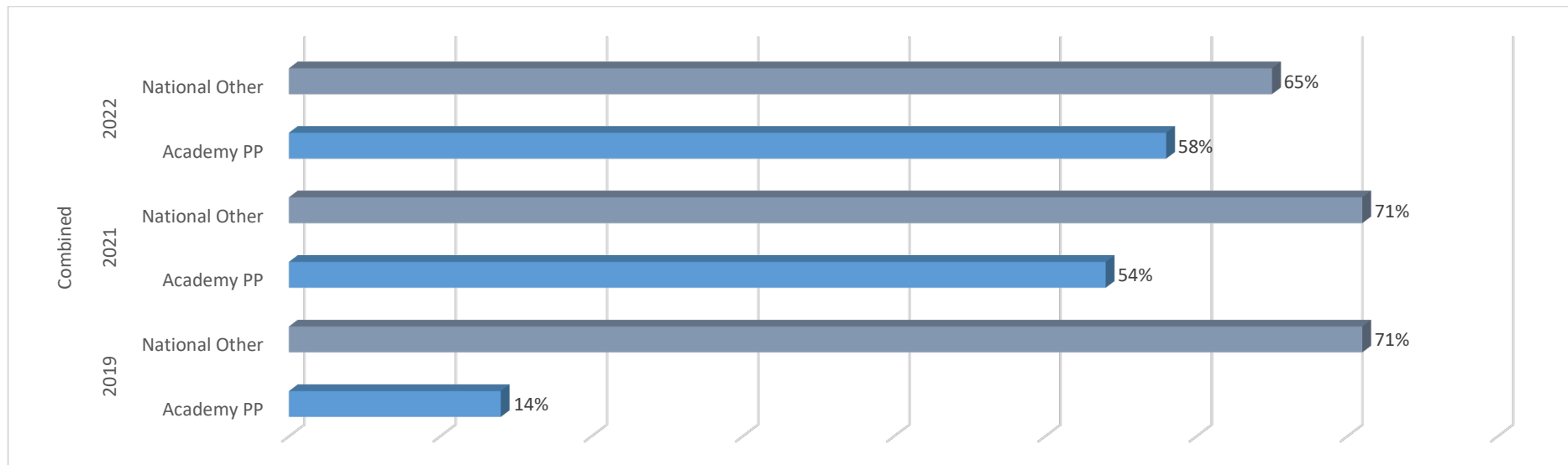

#### Key Stage 2 Pupil Premium - Attainment

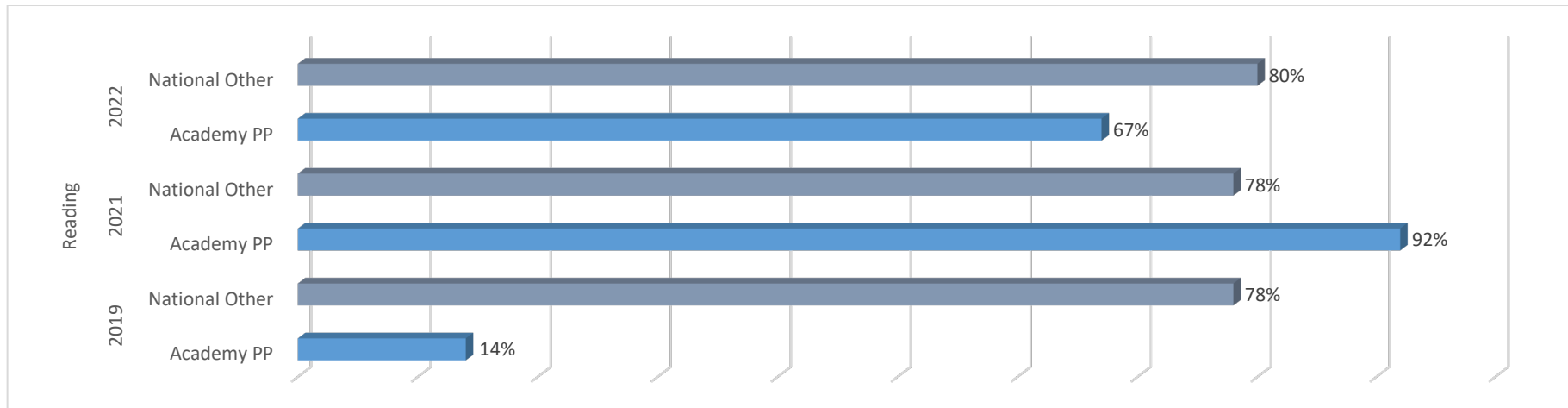
Key Stage 2 national curriculum test outcomes for reading, grammar, punctuation and spelling, and mathematics report whether pupils are working at the EXPECTED STANDARD. Writing is not tested, and so Teacher Assessment (TA) reports whether pupils have reached the EXPECTED STANDARD.

The following graphs show a three year trend of attainment of PP in the academy compared with that of 'National Other' (all non-disadvantaged pupils nationally). The 2022 figures are based on 12 Pupil Premium Funded pupils.

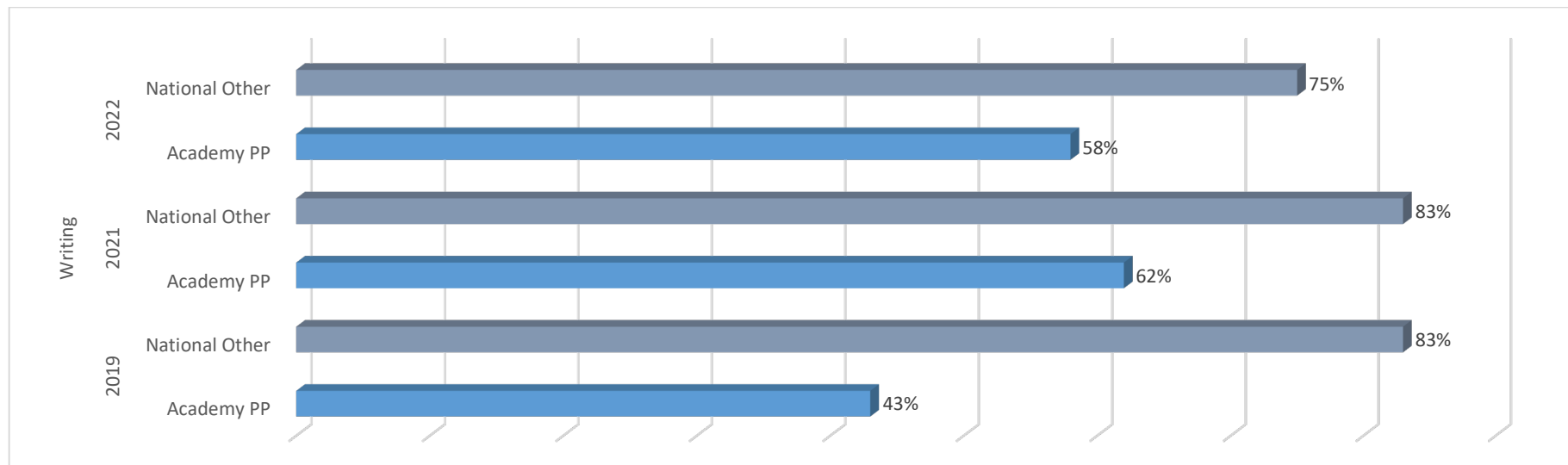
Year 6 Pupils achieving **at least the EXPECTED standard in Reading, Writing and Mathematics Combined**.



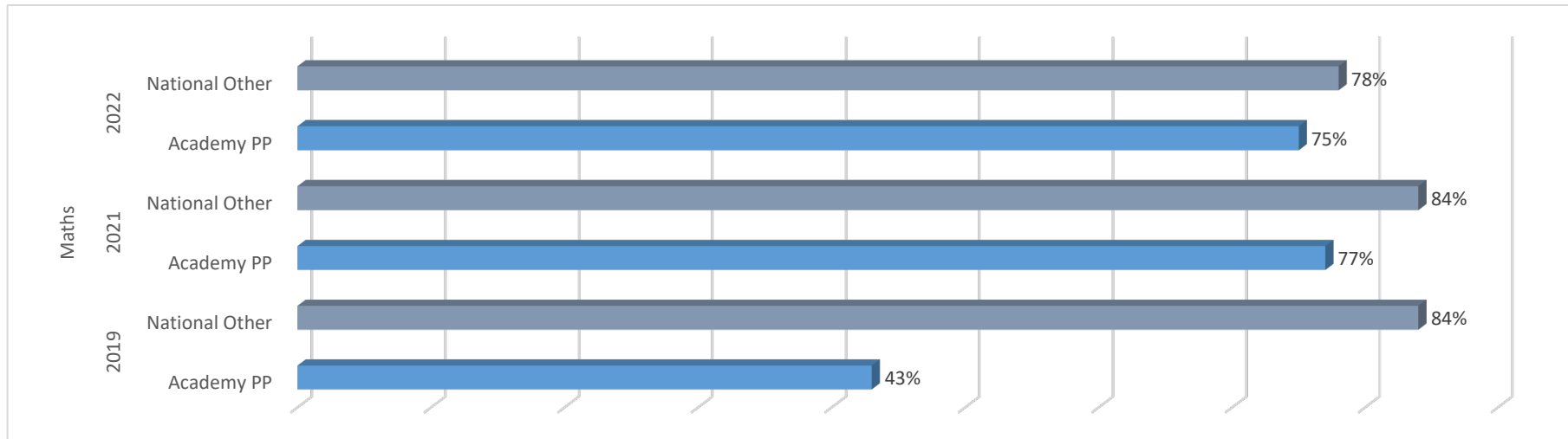
Year 6 Pupils achieving **at least the EXPECTED standard in Reading.**

**Key Stage 2 Pupil Premium - Progress**

Progress in reading, writing and mathematics is calculated using the pupils' end of KS1 results to the end of KS2 results.

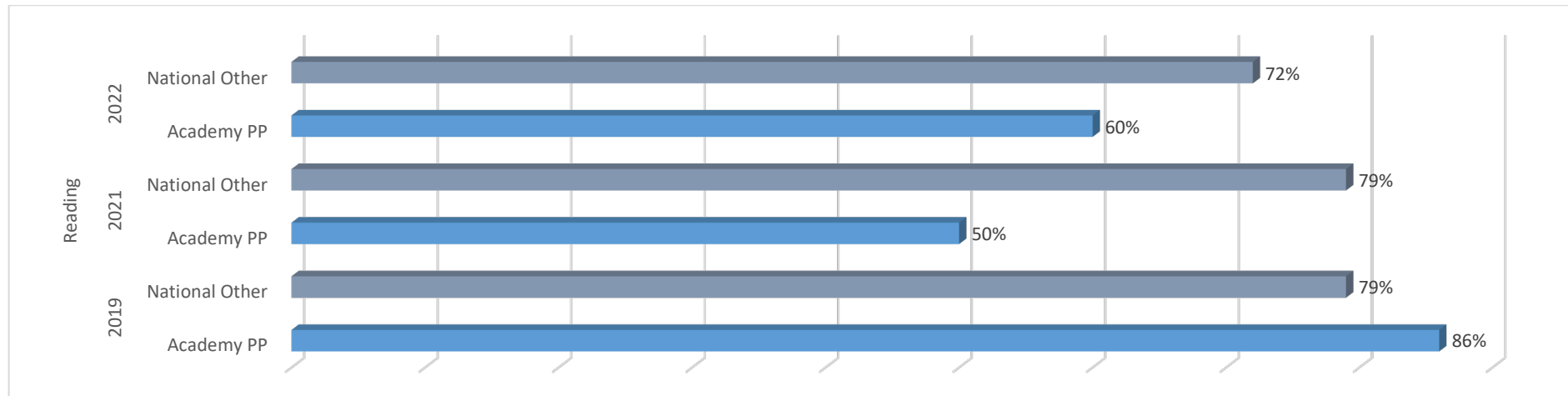

## Key Stage 1 Pupil Premium - Attainment

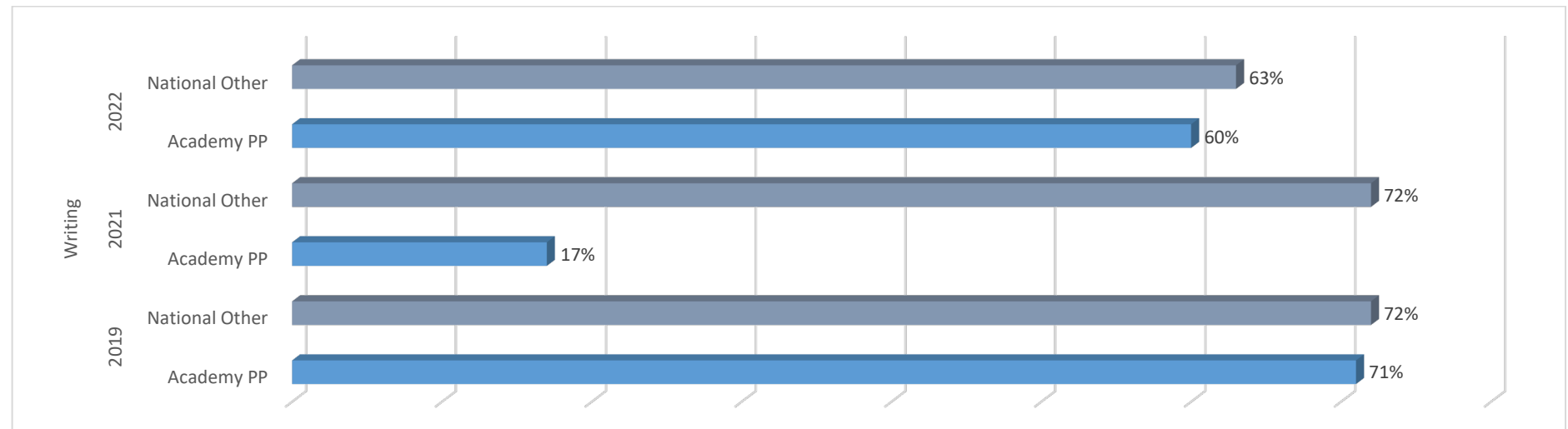
At Key stage 1, teacher assessment is used for reading, writing and mathematics to report whether a pupil has achieved the EXPECTED STANDARD for the end of Key Stage 1. To support teacher assessment Pupils sit SAT's in May.

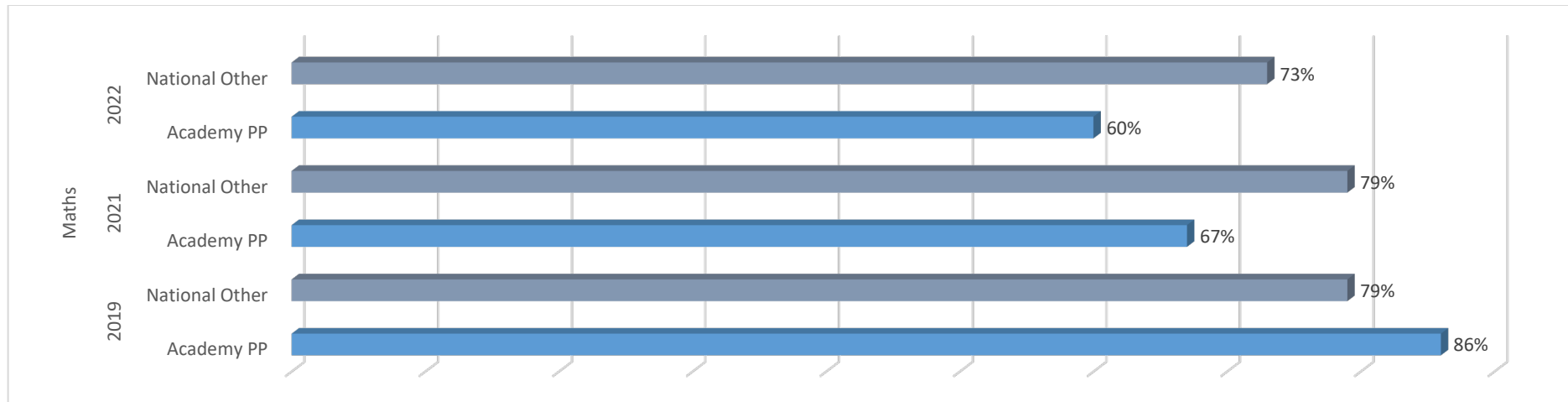
Year 2 Pupils achieving **at least the EXPECTED standard in Reading.**
