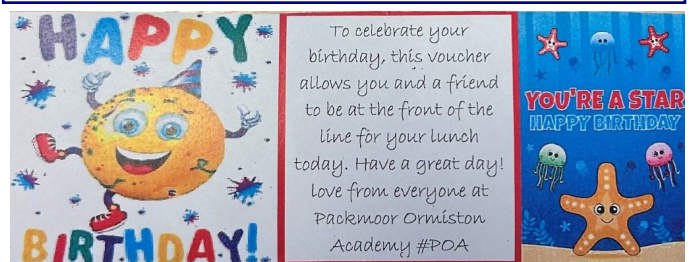
The Nutcracker
